House Rules

1. Bellevue Elderly Care LLC has a **zero** tolerance for abuse, neglect, financial exploitation or violation of the right of a resident.
2. There will be no smoking of any kind inside the house.
3. Television and radios are to be used at a level as not to disturb the other residents, whether it is in their room or the living room.
4. When using the telephone, please be considerate of the others who may also need to use it. Telephone line can be available in the room with an extra charge.
5. Family members are encouraged to visit at anytime. During meal time it's encouraged not to visits because this might make the resident distracted from meals and uncomfortable for the resident who can't feed themselves. Meal times are 8:00AM breakfast 12:00PM lunch and 5:00PM dinner.
6. When visiting resident has to ask the caregiver for help if they need to be transferred or need to use the bathroom.
7. No alcohol intoxication is allowed on the premises.
8. For the safety of resident and staff weapons, guns or knives are not allowed on the premise unless approved by provider.
9. Animals are welcomed to visit as long as a proof of rabies vaccination is provided to provider. The animal has to stay with the owner at all times. If other resident are upset of the animal the animal will have to be taken to the visiting resident room or outside on deck. If visitor is unable to provide paper proof then the animal will need to wait outside or have the visit on the deck outside. Service animal are allowed to enter the house.

Any resident in noncompliance with these rules may result in a 30day notice to vacate the premises.
